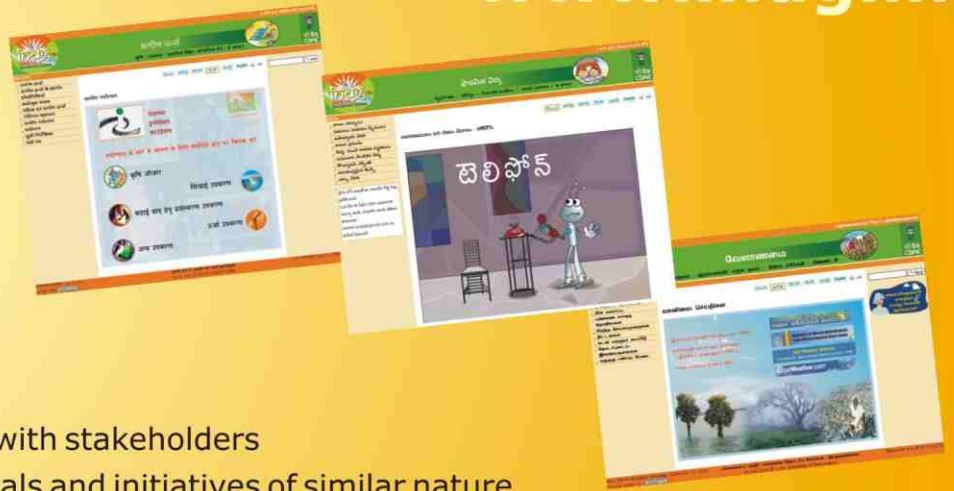
## Focus
